RELEASE

Any rider under the age of 13 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian. The adult rider will act as the supervisor of the child, and is responsible for his/her safety. All riders must wear helmets and follow local traffic laws.

ACKNOWLEDGMENT WAIVER AND RELEASE FROM LIABILITY AND POTENTIAL CLAIMS BASED ON NEGLIGENCE OR OTHER CLAIMED MISCONDUCT.

I acknowledge that the "Ride, for Pete's Sake!" carries with it the potential for death, serious injury and/or property loss. The risks include, but are not limited to, vehicular traffic and actions of participants, volunteers, spectators or organizers of the event. I hereby assume the risks of participating in the "Ride, for Pete's Sake!" to be held on August 21, 2004.

I certify that I am physically fit, have sufficiently trained for participation in this event, and have not been advised otherwise by a qualified medical person.

For and on behalf of myself, my executors, administrators, heirs, next of kin, successors and assigns, I hereby waive, release and discharge from any and all liability for my death, disabilities, personal injury, property damage, property theft or actions of any kind which may hereafter accrue to me as a result of my participation in this event the following persons or entities: event sponsors, event organizers, event volunteers and all cities, counties, districts and states in which the event may be staged or in which segments of the event may be held, and the officers, directors, employees, representatives, agents and volunteers of the foregoing. Further, I indemnify and hold harmless the persons or entities mentioned in this paragraph from any and all liabilities or claims made by other individuals or entities as a result of any of my actions during the event.

I hereby consent to receive medical treatment that may be deemed advisable in the event of injury, accident and/or illness during the event.

I understand that at this event I may be photographed. I agree to allow my photo, video or film likeness to be used for any legitimate purpose by the event organizers, event sponsors and/or assigns.

I understand that if I start the ride before the designated time, I may not have all the amenities including rest stops and police assistance that people starting at the designated time will have.

This form shall be construed broadly to provide a release and waiver to the maximum extent possible under the applicable law.

All riders must wear helmets and follow local traffic laws. A parent or guardian must accompany any child under 13.

CONSENT TO MEDICAL TREATMENT FOR MINORS

I hereby ratify and confirm the signature of a minor.

I realize and appreciate that there is a possibility of complications and unforeseen consequences in any medical treatment and I assume any such risk on the behalf of myself and said minor. I acknowledge that no warranty is being made as to the results of any treatment.

HELP FIGHT CP!

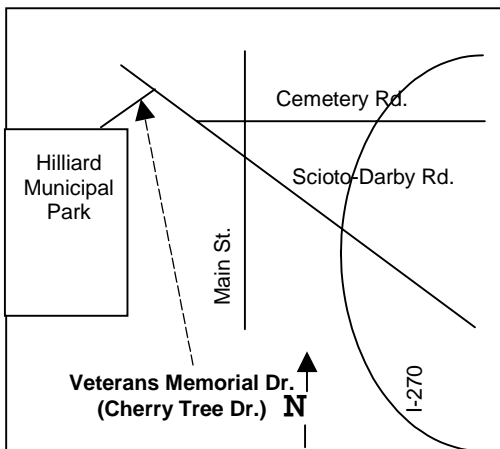
Cerebral palsy (CP) is a neurological condition that occurs during pregnancy or labor, or after birth, damaging the central nervous system. CP affects 500,000 to 700,000 Americans. Peter Zeidner, founder of Pedal-with-Pete, was born with CP, which has limited his ability to walk, use his hands and speak. The organization's goal is to raise funds for medical research to prevent, treat, and even reverse the effects of CP.

Ride Day Details:

Saturday, August 21, 2004
 Ride 7, 17, 35, 46, 78, or 100 miles
 Check in: 7:15-9:00
 NO rain date. Helmets Required.

Routes and Services: The "Ride, for Pete's Sake!" begins and ends at Hilliard Municipal Park. The 7-mile route is very flat, rolling along the Heritage Rail Trail and passing through Homestead Park. The 35 and 17-mile routes are mostly flat jaunts to the scenic Big Darby Creek. The 46-mile route follows flat to gently rolling terrain on lightly traveled township roads, following the Big Darby toward its source. The 78 and 100-mile courses follow the same route with additional loops featuring longer grades. *All routes are marked with arrows on the road, and include a rest stop with wonderful refreshments and water. Don't miss the food provided right at the start/stop point, too!*

Directions: Hilliard Municipal Park is slightly more than two miles west of I-270. From the Hilliard-Cemetery Road exit, drive west on Cemetery Road past the intersection with Scioto-Darby Road (just after the intersection with Main Street). The park is on Veterans Memorial Drive (Cherry Tree Drive), on the south side of the road.
